The parade is past the daffodil season; therefore, it is necessary to use cold storage daffodils for the parade. These flowers will have to be stored longer than is recommended for daffodils. The flowers you receive may be in full bloom, popped or buds. Blooms cannot be stored as long as buds. That is the reason for having to store the flowers in bud form. Having to store the flowers longer than normal can result in tired, sleepy flowers, that are hard to open and flowers with a short shelf life. The best quality daffodils will be stored for the festival. It is recommended (and very important) to give your daffodils a two-hour drink of water before using. This will greatly improve the condition of your flowers for the parade. (Suggestion: use flower box and line it with poly sheeting material to hold water and be sure to stand the daffodils upright.)

It is important that you contact Puyallup Valley Flower on the MONDAY prior to the parade to find out when it is recommended to pick up your flowers so you have time to open them if necessary.
